Individuals Assisted	41	Bridge Shelter: Provided 41 shelter guests services and assistance.
Contacts	100	Bridge Shelter: Made 100 contacts with shelter guests.
Linkage Type	Bridge Shelter	Updates
<u>Collaborative Case Management</u>	15	Bridge shelter: Inreach provided 15 linkages to collaborative case management services such as housing support services with case manager, medical linkages with hospital social worker, or mental health supportive services with mental health specialist.
<u>Housing Assessments</u>	6	Bridge Shelter: Inreach administered 6 housing assessment on shelter guest to assess their eligibility for government-subsidized housing.
<u>Documentation</u>	15	Bridge Shelter: Inreach offered shelter guests several documentation services such as assisting with completing and sending disabling condition forms, provision of identification card vouchers, consent forms, and provided homeless verification forms.
<u>Housing/Recovery Assistance</u>	20	Bridge Shelter: Inreach provided shelter guests with housing listings for affordable rooms and apartments in their area.
<u>Job Connection</u>	0	Bridge Shelter: Inreach did not provide any linkages to job resources during this reporting period.

<u>Legal Services</u>	1	Bridge Shelter: Inreach linked 1 shelter guests to legal services.
<u>Medical</u>	10	Bridge Shelter: Inreach assisted shelter guest in transferring multiple medical prescriptions to a local pharmacy, this will help client in tracking and managing their medication through one single pharmacy.
<u>Mental Health</u>	7	Bridge Shelter: Inreach contacted local psychiatric team for an emergency assessment as shelter guest was showing serious symptoms related to their mental health.
<u>Other</u>	2	Bridge Shelter: Inreach provides other services that include clothing, food supplies and general assistance.
<u>Rental Resources</u>	2	Bridge Shelter: Inreach linked 2 shelter guests to rental resources and rental assistance programs.
<u>Social Services</u>	4	Bridge Shelter: Inreach linked shelter guest to social services program that offers in home support benefits to support guest with their disability.
<u>Substance Abuse</u>	2	Bridge Shelter: Inreach linked 2 shelter guests to substance treatment programs.
<u>Transportation</u>	18	Bridge Shelter: Provided Bus Passes, Cab Rides, and other transportation services to support shelter guests' transportation needs.
Total Number of Linkages:	102	Bridge Shelter provided 102 linkages this number reflects all underlined linkages.
