



## WHAT IS A MASTER PLAN?

A master plan is a comprehensive, long-term strategy that guides the use, enhancement and management of a site's assets and open space within existing environmental and cultural constraints. The master plan provides a framework for future park improvements including trails, restoration projects, educational opportunities, amenities, and more.

## WHY IS THE FAIRVIEW PARK MASTER PLAN BEING UPDATED?

The original Master Plan was prepared and adopted from 1995-1998, and minor changes to the Plan were recognized in 2000-2008. Since 1998, the City has completed several significant projects to enhance and restore the site, and a wide variety of special-status plant and animal species have been documented. The City has evolved substantially since the original Master Plan was adopted and so have the geospatial tools to manage land and environmental resource assets. In addition, the update will account for environmental policy and regulatory changes that have occurred in the 25+ years since the Master Plan's adoption. The overall goal of this update is to provide a revised plan that, when implemented, will protect, preserve, and enhance the unique natural and cultural resources of Fairview Park as a passive open space park for generations to come.
