GUIDELINES FOR CONSIDERATION OF POSTING NO PARKING FOR STREET SWEEPING PURPOSES

1. A written request must be received from a resident of the street being considered or from City staff regarding posting due to street cleaning problems.
2. Requests for posting for street cleaning from single family residential and multi-family residential streets shall be treated in the same manner.
3. City staff must confirm that the area is difficult to sweep because of the number of parked cars, or the posting must be supported by a petition signed by residents of a majority of the legally permitted dwelling units in the affected area, as defined by No. 4 below. **Only one signature per dwelling unit will be counted.**
4. If the requirements of Item No. 3 above are met, staff will notify by mail all addresses of multiple unit residential complexes, and all homes on any lot that fronts or gains driveway access from the affected street, of the request and give residents the opportunity to comment prior to implementation of the parking restriction.
5. Special consideration will be given in areas with dense on-street parking. Consideration might include arranging for sweeping after 8:00 a.m., alternative side sweeping, or similar measures.
6. Once a request for posting of no parking for Street Sweeping purposes has been approved, it will not be reconsidered again by the City for a minimum period of nine (9) months.
