



# POLITICAL CAMPAIGN SIGNS



Political campaign signs are considered “non-commercial portable signs” in the City of Costa Mesa.

## DO

- ✓ Post signs on private property with prior consent of the property owner, lessee, or occupant.
- ✓ Post signs in any landscaped parkway.
- ✓ Post signs after Sept. 24 (6 weeks before the election), Signs may be up 24/7 during this period.
- ✓ Remove within 10 days after the election.

## DON'T

- ✗ Don't post signs on public property/right of ways such as utility poles, roadway signs, traffic control boxes, bus shelters, in tree wells, center median islands, overhanging a curb, sidewalk or driveway.
- ✗ Don't post in front of public facilities, including City Hall.
- ✗ Don't post signs without permission.
- ✗ Don't remove or tamper with other candidate's signs.
